BEAU BLANC wisconsin Dry white wine

Cedar Creek Beau Blanc is aged six months in French oak barrels and is a crisp classy dry wine with notes of quince and lemon.

Enjoy this wine cool with chicken, pork or seafood.

GRAPE | 100% Wisconsin-grown St. Pepin grape

PRODUCTION | Cool fermentation followed by malolactic fermentation,

METHOD battonage (stirring of the lees) to develop the smooth

creaminess of the wine while barrel aging.

AGING Six months in French oak barrels

SWEETNESS Dry

ALCOHOL 13%

SERVING TEMP. | Slightly cool

AGEABILITY 3 years

HISTORY | First vintage in 2018
