## BEAUJOLAIS LITTLE BROTHER JEAN-FRANCOIS

french family Dry red wine

A perfect family inspiration! This Beaujolais wine is a blend of our French family's two vineyards, located about 12 miles apart in the Beaujolais region of France.

This wine is made in the traditional Beaujolais style and is a light-bodied, classy wine. Well-balanced, with delicate fruit aromas reminiscent of raspberry and subtle earthy notes.

Enjoy at room temperature with summer sausage, white meats and pizza.

PRODUCTION METHOD	Beaujolais method, uncrushed berries
AGING	Four to eight months in large old casks
SWEETNESS	Dry
ALCOHOL	12.5%
SERVING TEMP.	Cool room temperature
AGEABILITY	3 - 5 years
HISTORY	Family import from Winemaker Phillipe's Brother since 2017
